

It had a farmyard at the back that opened on "Dovehouse Close". It is a small four roomed house, but the rafters are beautifully moulded & must be several centuries old. (This house was demolished, when the "Arkwright Family" moved to Hildersham in 1950's, after purchasing the land of Dovehouse Close & Dovehouse Meadow part of the Hildersham estate, from the then Lord of the Manor & principal landowner. "Mr Denys Alexander Shine Lawlor Huddleston esq." of "Sawston Hall" had a wooden House called "Thuy House" built in "Dovehouse Close", the wooden rafters from the old cottage, were used as fence posts in the paddock at the rear of the house.
