

Kingsway Solar **stage two** consultation is now open



The second stage of consultation (known as statutory consultation) has opened for Kingsway Solar, a proposed solar farm and overhead line connection to the national grid, located east of Cambridge, between Burwell and Balsham in Cambridgeshire.

The consultation will run for six weeks from **Wednesday 17 September 2025** until **Wednesday 29 October 2025**.
